

DAYTRIPPERS

Daytrippers was started by Iain Ogilvie, when he qualified for a concessionary bus pass and wanted to see where it could take him. The aim of our Daytrippers group is to visit places of interest in Scotland using our bus passes – it's as simple as that!

We meet at Cumbernauld Bus Station on an agreed date and, on arrival at our destination for the day, usually head for coffee and scones before visiting the main attraction. A packed lunch is usually brought along in the hope of dry weather (it happens some times!) and the opportunity to dine *al fresco*.

By and large, we have a trip once a month from April until September. However, due to the inclement weather, our first trip this year was in May, when we visited Glasgow Cathedral, St Mungo's Museum and Provand's Lordship. Further trips are planned to the Scottish Parliament, the National Museum of Scotland and Dunfermline Abbey, to name but a few.
